

The topic we will be covering this term is:

India

Literacy

In literacy this term we will be focusing on a range of genres to widen their application of key skills. These will include diary entries, letters, information texts and persuasive texts. We will relate these to our topic 'India'.

Maths

This term we will continue to extend your child's knowledge of calculation methods for all four operations.

Science

In science the children will be looking at the topic Of 'Living Things and Their Habitat'. They will identify habitats and how they provide basic need. They will name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats. They will understand how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals.

ICT:

Children will always use and develop their knowledge of e safety when using computers. They will be developing their computer skills including word processing and creating basic presentations. They will learn how to change font, size and colour.

Art/ DT

Children will continue to develop their drawing and painting skills. The children will create Rangoli patterns using different colours and shapes. They will look at and create their own henna designs. They will also look at and make models of famous landmarks in India.

Geography

The children will develop their map skills. They will name, locate and identify India on a world map. They will identify how the world is broken up into continents and how these include many countries. They will compare and contrast two places, by identifying the similarities and differences.

P.E.

The children will be shown how to exercise safely and describe how your body feels during activities. They will explore what your body needs to be healthy. They will continue to play a variety of team games.

R.E.

The children will learn about the festival of Diwali and the Hindu festival of light. The children will research why Hindus and Sikhs celebrate this, where it originated from and the symbols and traditions which are important to them.

Music

The children will listen to and describe Indian music. They will choose various musical instruments to add effect. They will choose musical instruments to represent different thoughts and feelings.

P.S.H.E.:

The children will be making wishes / targets for the year. They will continue to follow and understand what it takes to be a good friend and work as a team. The children will also look at E Safety and how this can be achieved.
