

This term our new topic is All About Me

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

Nursery:

Nursery: Children will become familiar with Nursery adults and routines. During group discussions, we will be talking about people who are special to the children.

Reception: The children will take part in various role-play scenarios which will encourage the children to interact with one another and develop positive relationships. They will be encouraged to talk to other children and communicate freely about their own home and community.

Physical Development

Nursery:

During our P.E sessions with Leaps and Bounds, children will be encouraged to help with their dressing and undressing of socks, shoes and jumpers

Reception: The children will be using PE/ outdoor equipment to experiment with different ways of moving, developing their confidence and skills. The children will be encouraged to use different equipment, such as scissors, pencils and threading tools, in order to develop their fine motor skills.

Communication and Language

Nursery:

During group discussions about people who are special to us, children will be encouraged to take turns to talk and listen to each other.

Reception

Children will participate in circle time activities such as show and tell. They will also share their weekend news with a partner and then with the class. Children will be encouraged to add detail and extend their vocabulary in their explanations.

Mathematics:

Nursery:

The children will be using simple shapes to make pictures of their houses and families.

Reception: Children will be counting various objects and developing their number recognition skills. The children will be learning how to find the total amount of two groups of objects. Children will be using shapes to create pictures. They will be discussing shapes and their properties. Children will be ordering, weighing and measuring various items.

Literacy

Reading:

Nursery:

The children will be listening to familiar tales about families and learning familiar nursery rhymes.

Reception

Children will have access to information and story books relating to the topic such as Goldilocks and the Three Bear, The Three Little Pigs and Kippers Birthday. Children will be encouraged to act out stories using puppets in our puppet theatre.

Writing:

Nursery:

Children will be accessing paints, pencils and other writing tools to make marks on paper.

Reception - Children will be writing their names, along with a list and a label linked to our topic. Children will have the opportunity to write party invitations and label birthday items. We will be focusing on correct letter formation and pencil grip. Across the EYFS setting, there are writing opportunities for every child in every area.

Understanding the World:

Nursery:

In role play, the children will be recreating every day actions and events from own family and culture e.g. ironing, looking after the baby, making meals etc.

Reception: Children will discuss what they did in their holidays. We will be looking at similarities and differences between themselves and others. Children will have the opportunity to taste different foods. They will create different images using tux paint on a computer.

Expressive Arts and Design:

Nursery:

Children will be colour mixing and painting people who are familiar to them.

Reception: Children will be using their creative skills to make models of their houses and family members. Children have access to a wide variety of materials that they can use to create themselves. They will also be drawing portraits of themselves. Children will also act out the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears.
