Dear Parent/Carer,

First, we would like to thank you for all your help and support this year with the systems and procedures we have had in place under the guidance for schools. We would now like to share with you the arrangements for returning to school this September. As we are continually risk assessing and receiving new guidance, please be aware that these plans may change in the future.

Return to school Tuesday 7th September 2021

All children will return to school on this date. We have decided to move children into home classes similar to those they were in before the pandemic. Your child will inform you who their teacher will be when they are told in school. The children will also work in ability groups in the mornings for Literacy and Maths and therefore will potentially work with both the year group teachers at some point.

Start and End of School Day Procedures

Year 4 will enter and leave via the hall doors on Key Stage 2 yard. Please arrive and leave the school site using the one-way system that is already in place as this eases congestion on site.

The start of the day is **8.50am** so the doors will open at **8.40am** for children to enter school. The end of the day will be **3.20pm**. To ensure your child's safety children who have been given permission to walk home (School must be informed first) will be released at **3.30pm**, after the children being collected have been handed over.

Uniform

Whilst we appreciate it has been challenging to get some elements of uniform this year, we expect all children to be in the correct school uniform for their return to school in September. This includes the correct PE kit in school colours which can be worn on their PE day. For details please see the school website.

Covid 19 positive cases

If your child tests positive for Covid 19 on either Saturday 17th July or Sunday 18th July please use the school email (at the top of this letter) to notify us of the result as this has implications for track and trace in school.
